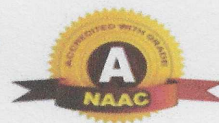

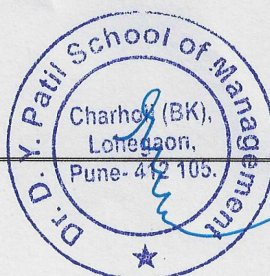

Engagement with stories sparks creative thinking and original ideas.

7. Improved Academic Performance

Better focus, comprehension, and language skills contribute to stronger results in school or study tasks.

8. Enhanced Empathy and Emotional Understanding

Reading diverse stories helps participants understand different perspectives and emotions.



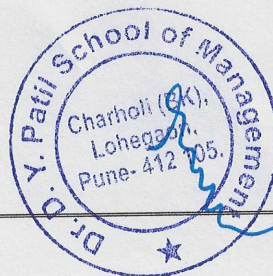
9. Increased Collaboration

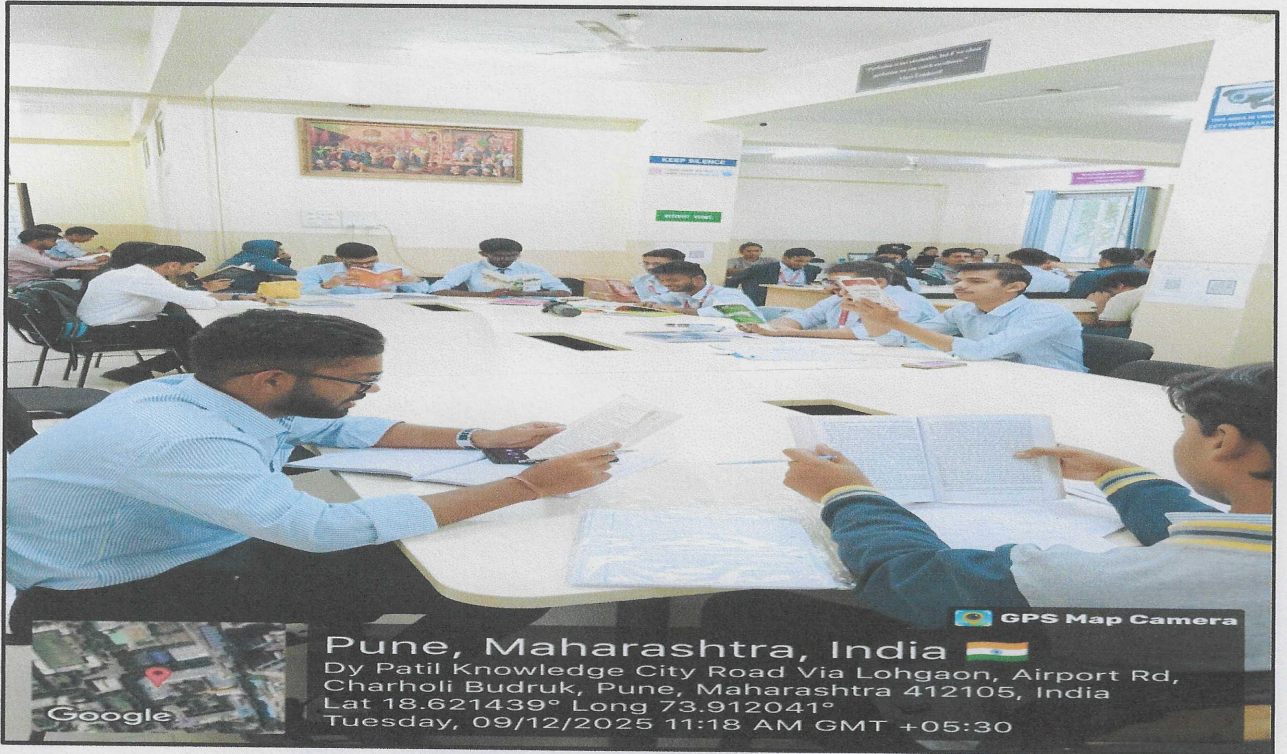
Participants learn to share ideas, listen to others, and work in groups during discussions and activities.

Reading becomes associated with enjoyment and curiosity, encouraging lifelong learning.

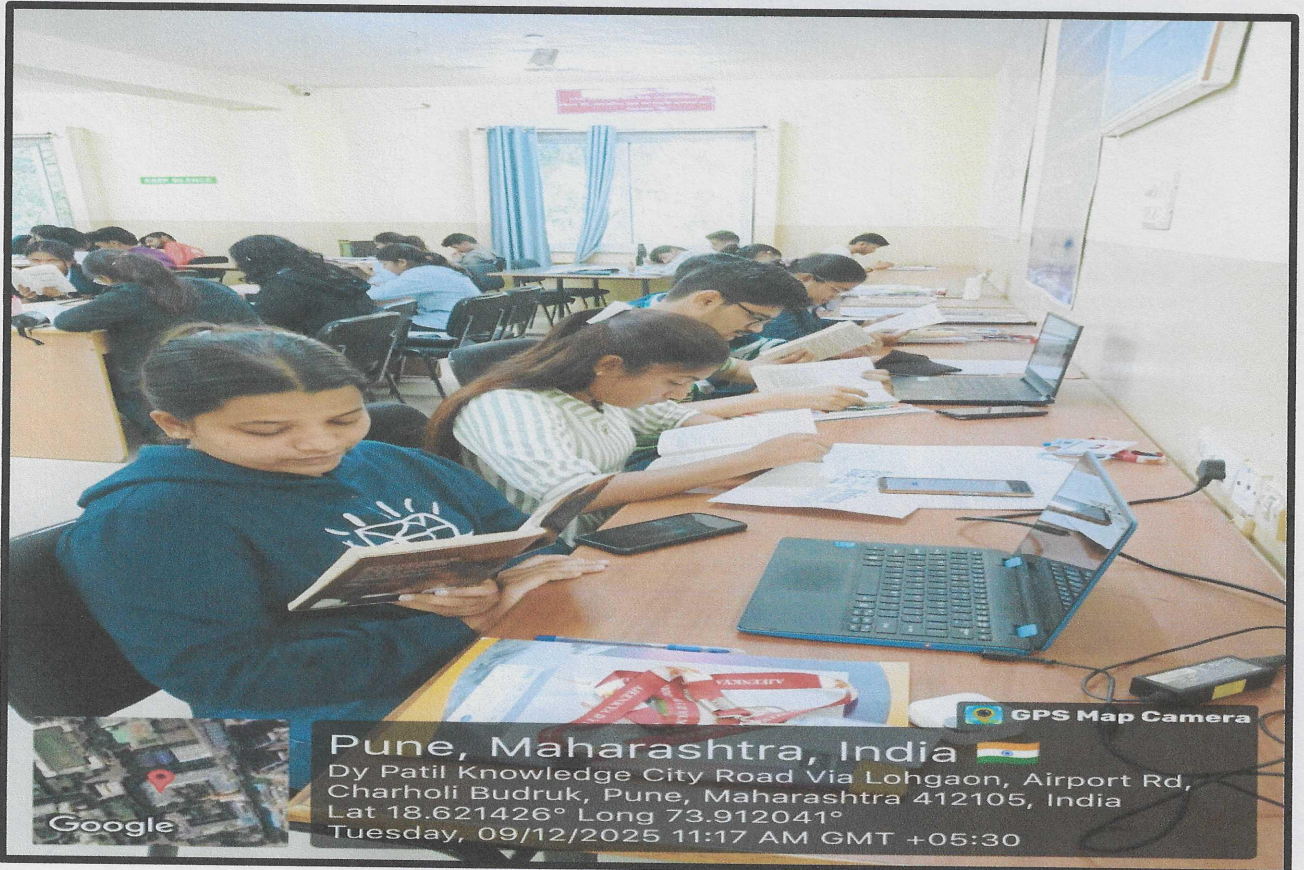
